Embracing Neurodiversity: Celebrating Differences, Promoting Inclusion, and Empowering Individuals


Dear AIMS families!

Monday, 18 to Sunday, 24 March marks Neurodiversity Celebration Week, a worldwide initiative working to transform the way neurodivergent people are perceived and to recognise the many advantages and talents that come with neurodiversity.

Neurodivergence refers to natural variations in how individuals' brains function and process information. It encompasses a range of neurological conditions, including but not limited to autism spectrum disorder (ASD), attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD), dyslexia, dyspraxia, Tourette syndrome, and others. Neurodivergent individuals often have unique strengths, perspectives, and ways of experiencing the world.

Ensuring inclusion and acceptance of neurodivergent individuals involves creating environments that recognize and celebrate these differences while providing support and accommodations to enable their full participation. Here are some strategies for promoting inclusion and acceptance:

- Education and Awareness: Foster understanding and awareness of neurodiversity among staff, students, and the wider community. Provide training sessions, workshops, or educational materials to increase knowledge about various neurological conditions and dispel misconceptions.

- 無障礙環境:設計無障礙和包容性的實體空間和教育材料。規劃設施和活動時,請考慮感官敏感度、溝通偏好和移動需求等因素。
- 靈活的方法:在教學方法、評估和溝通方式上採用彈性,以適應不同的學習 偏好。提供作業的替代格式、提供視覺教具並利用輔助技術來支援神經分 歧的學生。

AIMS K12: Springing Forward with Student Achievements and College Success!

Spring brings an array of opportunities for AIMS K12 students, who are reaping the rewards of their winter efforts. Among these opportunities, a Junior has been selected for Pre-College Summer courses at Brown University, while three others secured internships at Berkeley University's Science Center. Meanwhile, our seniors achieved an impressive 100% acceptance rate into various four-year colleges, including prestigious institutions like UCSF, UCLA, and Stanford.

On March 11th, 20 students explored CSU San Jose, discovering unique opportunities such as obtaining a pilot license upon graduation. Additionally, we prioritize minimizing student debt by actively pursuing scholarship opportunities, including the Oakland Promise Scholarship, with 21 eligible students and an 86% completion rate this year, thanks to the efforts of Mr. Kabeer and the counseling staff.

College awareness initiatives are district-wide, with middle and elementary schools kicking off College Awareness Month. Berkeley MixedUP provided our 8th graders with first-hand college life experiences, while our Elementary School Student Government Association launched college awareness boards and a spirit week, promoting college visibility.

Wrapping up March, our 8th graders eagerly anticipate a tour of Merritt College on March 27th to explore college possibilities.

春天為 AIMS K12 學生帶來了一系列機會, 他們正在收穫冬季努力的回報。在這些機會中, 一名大三學生被選中參加布朗大學的大學預科暑期課程, 另外三名學生則獲得了柏克萊大學科學中心的實習機會。同時, 我們的高年級學生以令人印象深刻的100% 錄取率進入各個四年制大學, 包括加州大學舊金山分校(UCSF)、加州大學洛杉磯分校(UCLA) 和史丹佛大學(Stanford) 等著名院校。

3月11日,20名學生探索了科羅拉多州立大學聖荷西分校,發現了獨特的機會,例如畢業後獲得飛行員執照。此外,我們優先考慮透過積極爭取獎學金機會來減少學生債務,其中包括奧克蘭承諾獎學金,在 Kabeer 先生和諮詢人員的努力下,今年有21名符合資格的學生,完成率為86%。

大學意識活動在全區展開,中小學啟動了大學意識月。柏克萊 MixedUP 為我們的 八年級學生提供了第一手的大學生活體驗,而我們的小學生政府協會則推出了大學 意識委員會和精神週,提高了大學的知名度。

三月即將結束, 我們的八年級學生熱切期待 3 月 27 日參觀梅里特學院, 探索大學的可能性。


