College-bound Kid's Corner

AIMS Students Celebrate College Acceptances Amidst Financial Aid Challenges and Changing Admission Landscape

College Bound Kids are going to college! This month has been very special for our senior class as they receive many college admissions offers. Students have been accepted to many schools including Stanford, UC Berkeley, Cal Poly, UC Irvine, San Jose State, San Francisco State, Hampton, Clark-Atlanta, Fisk and many more. Although many students have gotten the good news of their acceptances, almost none have received their financial aid packages from their schools. With Intent to Register deadlines swiftly approaching, this is a critical challenge for our students. Some have to make the decision without knowing the cost. But here at AIMS we are proactive, actively searching for scholarship opportunities.

This year we had an 80% completion rate for our Oakland Promise Scholarships. This is a local scholarship that awards students scholarships ranging from \$2K-16. Fortunately eight students will receive the highest \$8- \$16k scholarship that pays out every year. For our Juniors, SAT scores came inline with state and regional averages around 950. Earlier this month Harvard, CalTech and all of the top Ivy Ranked schools announced that as of 2025, the schools will mandate standardized test scores as a part of their application process.

This will have a huge impact on college admissions for our student demographic but AIMS remains vigilant offering SAT/ACT Prep as a part of our courses for students. Beyond high-school, our elementary and middle schools enjoyed college tours of UC Berkeley and Merritt College, completed mock applications and attended college readiness assemblies that got everyone thinking, where do I want to go to college?

AIMS 學生在經濟援助挑戰和不斷變化的招生環境中慶祝大學錄取


上大學的孩子們要上大學了！這個月對我們的高年級學生來說非常特別，因為他們收到了許多大學錄取通知。學生已被許多學校錄取，包括史丹佛大學、加州大學柏克萊分校、加州理工大學、加州大學歐文分校、聖荷西州立大學、舊金山州立大學、漢普頓大學、克拉克-亞特蘭大大學、菲斯克大學等。儘管許多學生已經收到了被錄取的好消息，但幾乎沒有人收到學校的助學金。隨著意向註冊截止日期的迅速臨近，這對我們的學生來說是一個嚴峻的挑戰。有些人必須在不知道成本的情況下做出決定。但在 AIMS，我們積極主動地尋找獎學金機會。


今年，我們的奧克蘭承諾獎學金完成率為 80%。這是一項當地獎學金，為學生提供 2K-16 美元不等的獎學金。幸運的是，八名學生將恢復每年支付的最高 8-16,000 美元獎學金。對於我們的三年級學生來說，SAT 成績與州和地區平均水平一致，約為 950。學校將強制要求標準化考試成績作為其申請流程的一部分。


這將對我們學生群體的大學入學產生巨大影響，但 AIMS 仍然保持警惕，將 SAT/ACT 準備課程作為我們學生課程的一部分。除了高中之外，我們的小學和初中還參觀了加州大學柏克萊分校和梅里特學院的大學之旅，完成了模擬申請並參加了大學準備集會，這讓每個人都在思考，我想上哪裡的大學？

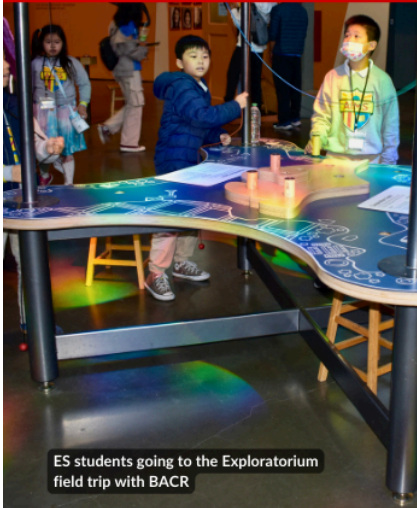

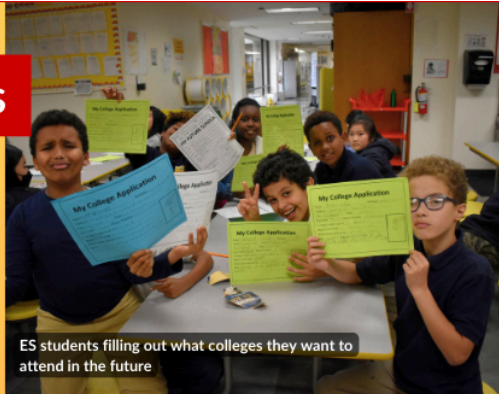

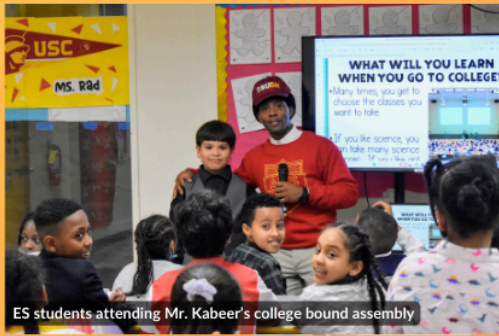

Spring into Language Learning: Family-Friendly Activities for Springtime Fun!

Middle School Implements Technology Pause for Enhanced Focus and Academic Development

The Middle School Focus has remained on dialing back use of technology and SBAC prep. Upon ending Quarter 3 on March 25th, we focused and shifted our work towards diagnostic assessments to gauge where our students are in their learning, and we planned forward towards SBAC prep. All students received SBAC prep workbooks for their respective grade level and subject (Math and ELA). Additionally, we enforced a Technology Pause to ensure your students are putting pencil to paper and expressing their learning.

04/12/24_Quarter 4 Technology Pause + Chromebook Inventory

Students will receive paper-based assignments from their teachers for classwork and homework. This includes and is not limited to individualized SBAC Prep workbooks, library books, textbooks, science workbooks, and specific homework assignments and projects. We believe that this will have several benefits for our students, including:

1. 🔍 **Improved Focus:** With fewer distractions, students will be able to concentrate better on their work, resulting in better academic performance.
2. ✍️ **Improved Writing Skills:** Handwriting skills and expressing oneself through written language are important aspects of education. With paper-based assignments, students will have more opportunities to hone these skills.
3. 🧠 **Improved Critical Thinking:** Paper-based assignments require students to engage with the material more deeply, promoting critical thinking skills.
4. 📖 **Improved Memory Retention:** Students retain information better when they write it down by hand.

3. 🧠 **提升批判性思考:**紙本作業要求學生更深入接觸材料，提升批判性思考能力。
4. 📖 **提升記憶力:**學生手寫時可以更好地記住資訊。

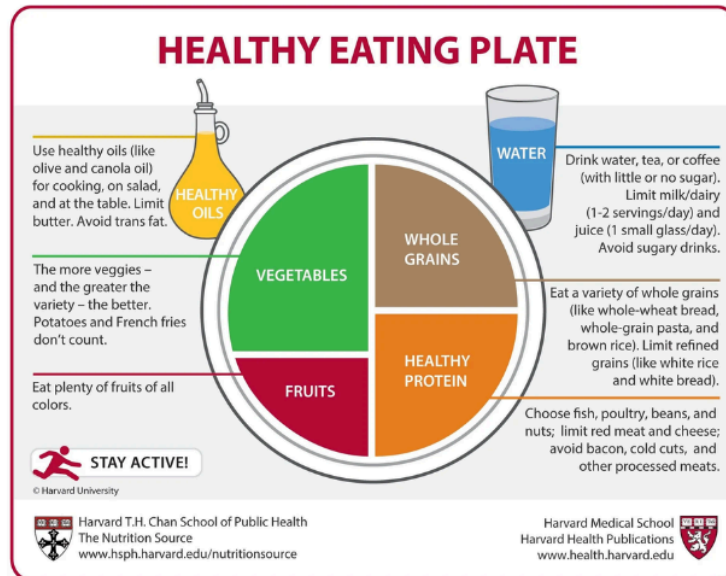

🎓 **AP Exams in May:** Next month, students will be taking AP Exams. Students: remember to review your notes, practice past exams, and get plenty of rest leading up to test day. An excellent score on an AP Exam will count towards college credit and ultimately save you money on your higher education.
